

Generic letters lose pharma roles.

Use this checklist to turn your cover letter into role-specific evidence for QA, QC, RA, validation, production, or clinical roles.

PHARMA COVER LETTER EVIDENCE CHECKLIST

Goal

Show fit with proof, not generic enthusiasm.

Use for

Freshers, career changers, and experienced candidates.

Outcome

A cleaner letter built around employer risk and value.

Start with job evidence

Before writing, collect the facts that make your application specific.

Role target

Job title, department, seniority, location, and work setting.

Employer signal

Pipeline, products, quality priorities, market focus, or recent news.

Keyword match

GMP, SOPs, validation, QC testing, deviation, CAPA, data integrity.

Candidate proof

Coursework, project, audit exposure, lab task, metric, or certificate.

Review checklist item: add a mini “before writing” research process to make the article more useful than sample-only competitor pages.

Translate your experience into pharma language

Recruiters need to see role alignment quickly.

Instead of this

I worked in a lab.
I am detail-oriented.
I followed procedures.



Write this

I supported controlled testing, followed approved SOPs, documented observations accurately, and escalated abnormal results for review.

Add terms only when true

Use GMP words as evidence, not decoration. Never claim responsibilities you cannot explain.

Prove fit with small results

One measured example can beat a long generic paragraph.

Role	Evidence	Value shown	Rule Use numbers when available: time, errors, batches, samples, documents, audits, or training hours.
QA	Supported deviation review	clearer evidence trail	
QC	Prepared samples and checked records	fewer documentation gaps	
Validation	Helped organize protocol evidence	faster readiness review	
RA	Compared submission requirements	better document accuracy	

Before you send: 8 checks

Use this as the downloadable checklist inside the blog.

- One page only
- At least one evidence example
- Named role and company
- Clean greeting and closing
- No copied template language
- Resume and letter align
- 2–3 pharma keywords
- No spelling or formatting errors
