Free access is not always a free certificate

Check the certificate conditions before you present the course on your CV.

Free course access

Learning content may be available without payment. This helps learners explore a topic first.

Assessment and proof

Some courses require a quiz, assessment or completion rule before proof can be issued.

Certificate condition

A downloadable certificate may require a subscription or single-course purchase.

Best practice: add “Certificate requires payment” near course CTAs and image captions.

Start with your target pharma role

Your role goal should decide which course deserves your time.

Target role	Best starting course	Why it helps
QA / QC beginner	Introduction to GMP	Builds basic control and compliance language
Sterile manufacturing	Introduction to Annex 1	Connects cleanroom behaviour with contamination control
Drug safety	Introduction to Pharmacovigilance	Explains cases, reporting and PV system basics
Career changer	GMP + one role course	Creates a foundation before specialization

If two or more items are unclear, compare another course before committing your study time.

Build your 90-day pharma learning plan

Turn free learning into structured career progress.

Days 1–30 Build foundations

Study GMP basics, pharma quality language and core documentation expectations.



Days 31–60 Specialize by role

Choose one area: QA, QC, manufacturing, Annex 1, PV, RA or clinical research.



Days 61–90 Create evidence

Prepare CV bullets, LinkedIn proof, interview examples and a learning summary.

Turn learning into career proof

Courses help more when you can show what you learned.

CV bullet

Completed role-relevant GMP training and applied documentation principles to QA examples.

LinkedIn proof

Post one learning summary with one concept, one takeaway and one target role.

Interview answer

Use the course to explain a control, decision, document or risk example.

Evidence formula

Course topic + pharma control + role example = stronger application proof

Final course selection checklist

Use these questions before choosing your next free pharma course.

- Does it match my target role?
- Is the syllabus practical and clear?
- Is the level right for me?
- Do I know the time commitment?

- Is the certificate condition clear?
- Is there an assessment or quiz?
- Can I add proof to my CV?
- What should I learn next?

Next step: choose one course, complete it, then turn it into one visible career proof item.
